Gender/Age **Groups**

The Female races are for people who were born as female. The male races are Open to all genders. Masters and U20s can enter their own age group or as a Senior but will only count towards the individual and team events in the age group as declared on the entry.

Eligibility to compete

Do not enter this event unless you are eligible for Warwickshire. County qualification is either by birth in the County, by 9 months continuous residence prior to competition in the County or by 9 months service in a unit of HM forces stationed in the County.

The Warwickshire County is defined as the Warwickshire pre-1974 boundary which includes

Birmingham, Coventry, Solihull and present Warwickshire areas.

Athletes must be current first claim members of the Club for which they have entered. Rules

Only Clubs Affiliated to Warwickshire County AA will be eligible for team awards. Only first claim athletes are eligible to score in the team competition. Any number of eligible Athletes can be entered

per Club. All athletes must wear a club or representative vest.

In events where age groups are combined, athletes will only be eligible for awards in the race **Awards** category (age group) for which they have entered. In the case of equal team scores, the first team to

close will be declared the winner. Please note that B-teams are not eligible for Team Awards as this is an event for Clubs. The Heeley Trophy, (best overall club) is judged on finishers across all age

Entry fee and closing date

Masters and Seniors £7.50 per individual. All other age groups (U11 – U20) £6.00.

Entries must arrive no later than 23:59 on Saturday 23rd November 2024. Entries are not valid unless the entry fee is paid. WCAA bank details for submission of fees are on the entry form. If the event is cancelled, the entry fees will be refunded less 20% to cover unavoidable costs.

Entry system

Team entries are preferred. Note there is an additional fee of £0.75 for entries submitted individually. Entries of 2 or more athletes on the same form and paid together do not incur the premium. Entries to be submitted using the form provided and emailed to secretary@warwickshireathletics.co.uk.

Programmes

There will be no printed programme on the day. You will be able to download one from the County

web site after entries have closed and have been compiled.

Inter-counties These Championships are the principal criteria for selection to the Inter Counties Cross Country Championships (All age groups U13 and above) to be held in March 2025. Selection for each age group team will be determined by the first three eligible athletes to cross the line in each race. The rest of the team will be selected by Team Managers. The County Association and its Team Managers reserve the right to exclude athletes who have previously been disrespectful to the Association or its Officers. See the County web site for a full description of the selection policy.

Anti-doping rules

An entrant shall be deemed to have made him/her/their self, familiar with, and agreed to be bound by the UKA Anti-Doping Rules and to submit to the authority of UK Anti-Doping in the application and enforcement of the Anti-Doping Rules. The UKA Anti-Doping Rules apply to entrants participating in the sport of Athletics, for 12 months from the date of entry, whether or not the licence holder is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK.
